

REGULATORY REQUEST SYSTEM (RRS)

What is it? A national online application portal and management platform which provides general information on the Regulatory Program and allows users to submit pre-application meeting requests, jurisdictional determination requests and individual and general permit applications, saving time and reducing the need for paper-based submissions.

Applicants can also track the status of their requests using a user-friendly dashboard. Users are required to create an account using Login.gov to submit online requests and to received status updates.



What's next? Adding new capability to include Self Verification Tools, Sharing with External Partners, and more.







RRS – PUBLIC NOTICE MODULE

- Users can search, review, and comment on open public notices.
- RRS organizes notices by state and district, which can be viewed in a table format or on an interactive map.
- Users can easily search for notices by project name or address and submit comments directly through the platform.









RRS – NO PERMIT REQUIRED MODULE


All processes work through the same basic steps:



The 'No Permit Required' Module will walk the applicant through a series of questions resulting in one of three outcomes for either No Activity NPR or an Exemption NPR:

ADDITIONAL ENHANCEMENTS
