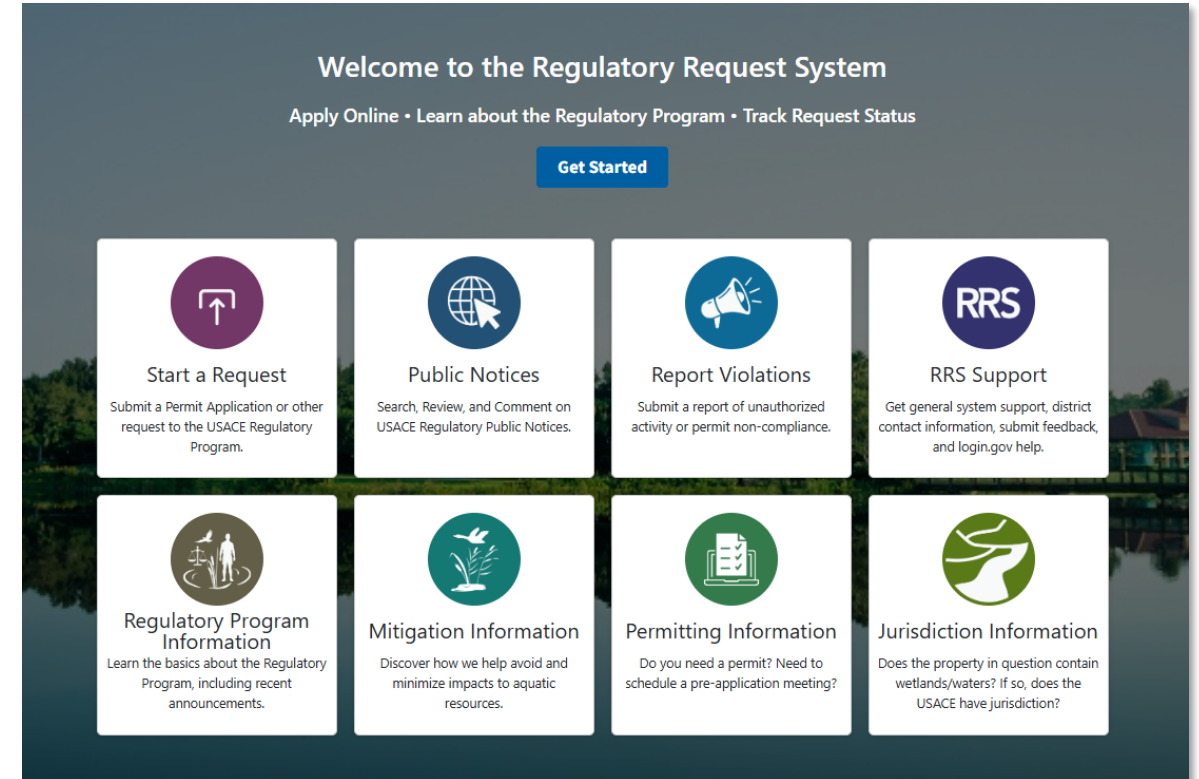

REGULATORY REQUEST SYSTEM (RRS)

What is it? A national online application portal and management platform which provides general information on the Regulatory Program and allows users to submit pre-application meeting requests, jurisdictional determination requests and individual and general permit applications, saving time and reducing the need for paper-based submissions.

Applicants can also track the status of their requests using a user-friendly dashboard. Users are required to create an account using Login.gov to submit online requests and to received status updates.

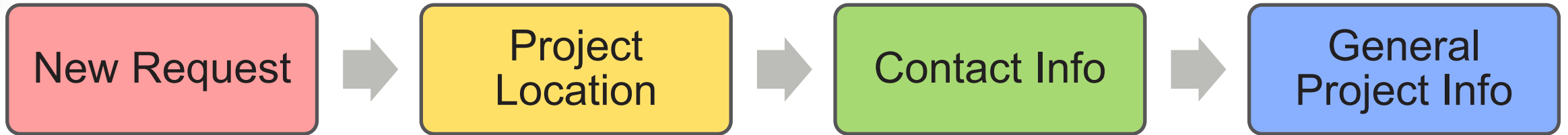

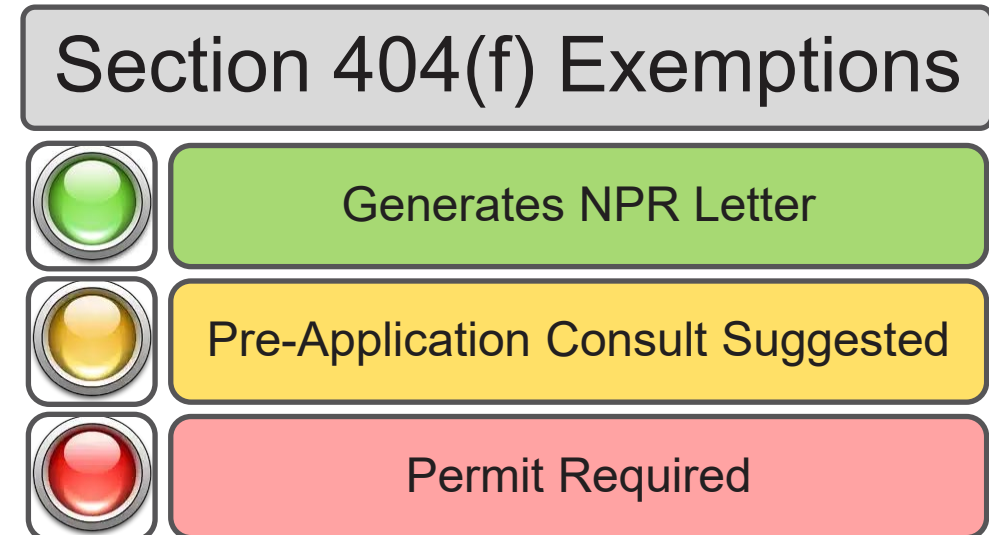
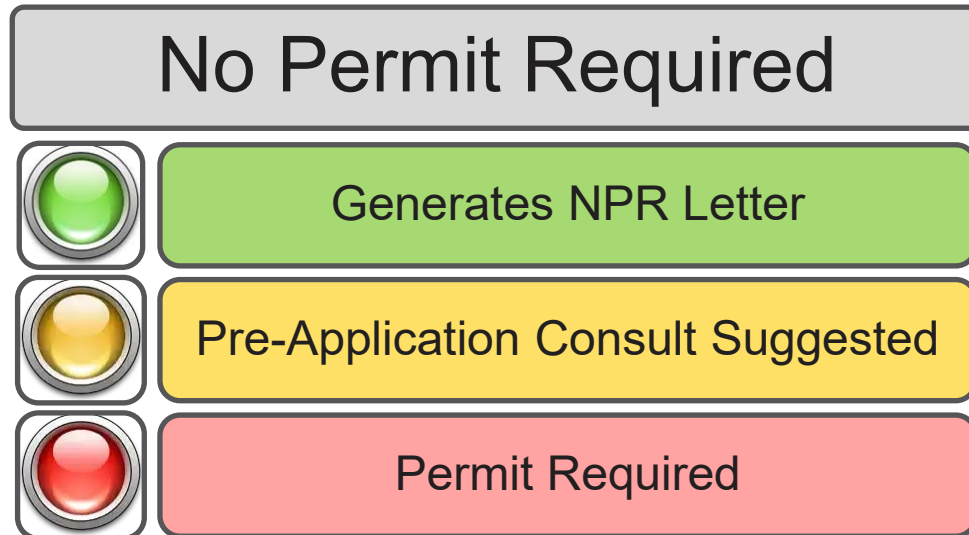


RRS – NO PERMIT REQUIRED MODULE

All processes work through the same basic steps:

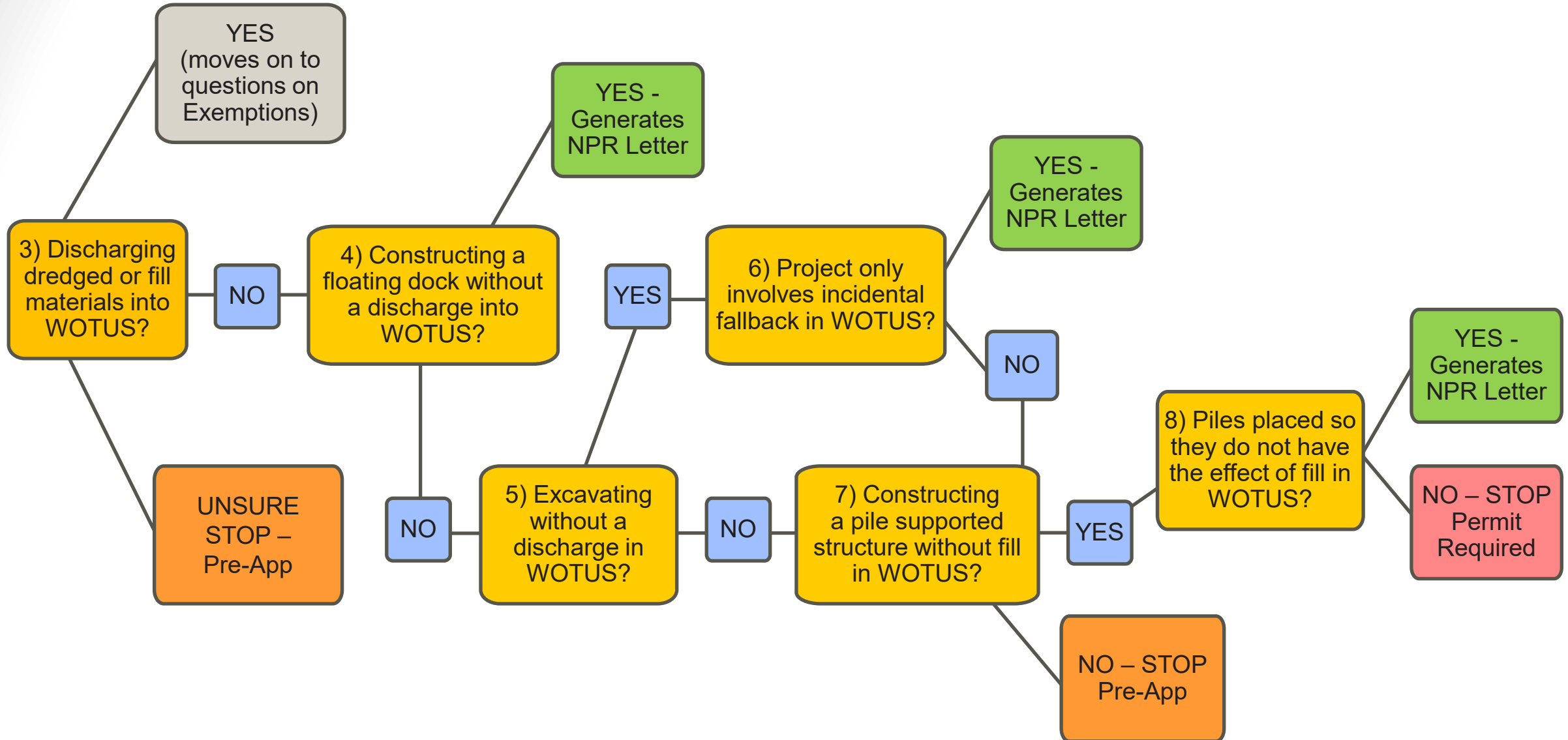


The 'No Permit Required' Module will walk the applicant through a series of questions resulting in one of three outcomes for either No Activity NPR or an Exemption NPR:

ADDITIONAL ENHANCEMENTS

- Bulk Uploads
- Non-Pre-Construction Notification Self Verification Tools (Non-Reporting GPs)
- Request Additional Information Functionality
- Data Sharing with External Agencies
- Expanded dashboard for improved tracking and status updates
- Modifications
- Submittal of multiple requests at once
(*e.g., delineation report & permit application request*)
